INFORMATION YOU MAY FIND HELPFUL BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT:

Things to bring with you to your appointment:

- Referral slip and any x-rays given to you by the referring doctor. If you do not have them, please contact your referring doctor and have them emailed to our office. If they have questions, please have them call our office. The secure office email they may send these to is: frontdesk@trilliumoralsurgery.com.
- Driver's license or photo ID, and both dental and medical insurance cards.
- Medical history, including a list of any medications that you take.
- Minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Financial/Insurance information:

- **Dental:** We participate with Delta Dental only. We can usually submit a claim to most other dental insurances, as long as your specific plan allows billing for out-of-network claims. We do not participate with or bill any dental discount plans, DMO/HMO plans, or state-funded (Medicaid) plans, such as MICHild/Healthy Kids. If you have questions regarding your insurance, please call our office.
- If you have Blue Cross Dental, please be aware that we collect our fees in full on the day services are provided. We will submit a claim to Blue Cross on your behalf, and they will pay you directly.
- **Medical:** We do not participate with any medical insurances. This includes Medicare and Medicare Advantage plans.
- Payment will be due at the time service is rendered. We will take into account any expected insurance coverage.
- Please familiarize yourself with how your insurance handles benefits with oral surgery. Oral surgery is often a covered benefit by dental insurance, but every plan is different. It is also important to know the annual maximum benefit allowed by your plan and your remaining balance.

Medical/Health information:

- Please inform our office if you have any severe medical conditions or have had any recent surgeries.
- If you take any prescription medications, discuss with our doctor which ones to take - including (but not limited to) blood thinners, chemotherapeutic, or osteoporosis medications (bisphosphonates).

General Anesthesia ("sleep") instructions:

- No food or drink (including water) for 6 hours prior to your procedure. You may brush your teeth, just do not swallow the water. If you take daily medications, you may take them with a small sip of water.
- A responsible adult will need to accompany you to the appointment and must remain in our office during your procedure and drive you home afterwards.
- If possible, please wear a short-sleeved shirt.
